COUCHICHIING JUBILEE HOUSE

Since 2001, Couchiching Jubilee House has offered hope and new direction to over 60 families. The premise is simple: provide transitional housing for a maximum of one year and a program of ongoing individualized support for vulnerable, homeless women and children.

The needs are complex: homelessness, poverty, abuse, mental health and addictions. The outcomes are transformative. Jubilee House offers four furnished apartments to women who are motivated to change their lives. They provide them with individualized and group support, and engage them in a “Wraparound” process that builds on their strengths. Each woman actively works towards her future independence, and emerges from Jubilee House with a strength that can last a lifetime. Every woman joins in the Post Resident program, once they have found themselves secure, affordable housing in the community. The bonds of friendship extend far beyond the year in residency. Jubilee House is more than a roof. It is the foundation of friendships and a brighter future.
