## Foreword

*All Our Days* combines the daily Prayer Cycle of the Diocese of Toronto with the Psalms and readings from the Daily Office Lectionary and the Eucharistic readings for Sundays and Feasts. Our hope is that, by utilising this resource, we may daily exercise our common devotions with one voice, upholding each other before God in mutual prayer.

*All Our Days* is compiled in order to be a handy reference for parishes and individuals, not a full guide to the services of the Church. For that, we invite you to refer to *McCausland's Order of Divine Service* (the Ordo), published by the ABC, and edited by the Sub-Dean of St James Cathedral, the Rev. Canon David Brinton. The Christian Year 2014 follows Year A of the Sunday Eucharistic Lectionary and Year 2 of the Daily Office Lectionary.

We now provide *All Our Days* solely as an electronic document, making it easy to access and share, and also saving considerably on the costs of unnecessary printing. For those who desire it however this format allows for downloading and printing as required.

The joint prayer cycle of the Anglican Church of Canada (ACC) and the Evangelical Lutheran Church in Canada (ELCIC) are now permanent fixtures in this publication. On Sundays, the prayer lists are now noted: **ACC** (Anglican), **ELCIC** (Lutheran) with our diocesan cycle of prayer included as the final entry. We regret that space does not permit us to include the world-wide Anglican Cycle of Prayer in this book.
