SESSION LEADERS

<u>Annual Vestry</u> – As per Canon 14(11)(2) the annual meeting of the vestry in every church should be held no later than the end of February each year and you must provide notice of the meeting during the services of the two preceding Sundays. If you are thinking of holding it after February you require the Bishop's Approval before proceeding.

<u>Diocesan Returns</u> - Incumbents Returns & Churchwarden's Parochial Returns are due at the Synod Office by **March 15** annually; see www.toronto.anglican.ca for details.

Registered Charity Information Return – Churchwardens are required to submit the T3010-1 form annually to the Canada Revenue Agency within six (6) months of your fiscal year end to maintain your charitable status; see www.cra-arc.gc.ca for the form and workbook.

Parishes can apply to Area Council for the following grant funding:

- Ministry Development Grants (MDG) reviewed at Area Council meetings throughout the year. Grants up to \$10,000. Next deadline for applications: May 19, 2017.
- FaithWorks Grants reviewed at Area Council meetings through-out the year. Grants up to \$5,000. Next deadline for applications: May 19, 2017.
- Building Inspection Grants \$500 grants towards the cost of building inspections.
- **Bursary Grants** \$500 bursary grants to support Area youth entering post-secondary education. Deadline for applications is May 17, 2017.

WHEN THE BISHOP'S SUPPORT IS REQUIRED

If you require the Bishop's support for anything that has to go to the Trusts Committee (as per Canon 6) prior to going to Diocesan Council you must submit the **complete** set of required documents to the Area Office <u>at least</u> 1 week prior to the diocesan due date. The Bishop will not send his support without reviewing the complete set of documents that you are submitting to Trusts.

The Bishop's support is required for all matters under Canon 6, including new Facility Rentals (License and Lease Agreements), Purchase and Sale of Property, Capital improvement projects/expansions, and Grants: the Baker Fund; the Carleton Fund; the Ferguson Trust; the Ministry Allocation Fund ("MAF"); and Our Faith Our Hope. Please note: for License and Lease Renewals the Bishop's support is not needed but we ask that you send an email indicating what you are renewing so that the Bishop knows what is happening at your parish.

Below are the dates for the 2016 Trust & Executive Committees and the submission deadline dates.

Our Faith Our Hope grants have their own process and can only be applied for twice a year. The next deadline is **April 15, 2017** – due to the nature of these grant applications and the approval the committee requires they should be sent to our office at least two weeks, if not sooner, before they are due at the diocese; i.e. to the Area Office by **April 1, 2017**.

License & Lease Agreements:

- 1. You must use the Diocesan templates found on the website, http://www.toronto.anglican.ca/parish-administration/real-estate/facility-rentals/. They are very simple, just look for the **BLUE** dots and replace with your information.
- 2. When filling out the License Agreement Schedules (pages 6-10) the more information about the licensed area, the fees, the activities permitted and the representatives you have, the better.
- 3. Before you send in your agreement for the Bishop's support make sure you have an unsigned agreement, the Certificate of Insurance from the Licensee or Lessee and, for lease agreements, only a certified Vestry motion approving the terms of the rental.
- 4. Dating your Agreement the agreement should not be dated before the date of the Diocesan Council Meeting it will be sent to.
- 5. Length of Agreement to save you from renewing every year you can enter into multiple year License agreements up to 5 years.
- 6. Certificate of Insurance the certificate holder must be listed as "The Incumbent and Churchwardens of" with the correct name of your church and physical address. You also have to request that <u>both</u> The Incumbent and Churchwardens of (church name) and The Incorporated Synod of the Diocese of Toronto are added as additional insureds. Make sure you take note of the coverage dates if the Licensee or Lessee policy ends part way through your agreement you need to obtain a new certificate from them prior to policy expiry to ensure that there is no lapse in coverage.
- 7. Once the Bishop has reviewed the documents he will either call you for clarification or send a memo to the Trusts Committee giving his support.
- 8. Renewal of Agreements must be re-approved by the Trusts Committee and Diocesan Council prior to expiry of the current term.

In all cases your churchwardens should contact the Area Office before starting a project to make sure the Bishop is informed.

OTHER GRANTS AND FUNDING OPTIONS

Grants from the **Baker Foundation** are for the building of or additions to existing Sunday Schools. See www.toronto.anglican.ca/parish-administration/grants-funding/baker-foundation-grants-2/.

The **Bishop's Company Fund** provides discretionary funds for the bishops to come to the aid of clergy and their families with emergency needs. www.toronto.anglican.ca/parish-administration/grants-funding/bishops-company/.

Carleton Fund Grants are for repairs and/or renovations to rectories occupied by clergy. See www.toronto.anglican.ca/parish-administration/grants-funding/carleton-fund-grants/.

Ministry Allocation Fund Grants (MAF) provides grants of loans for real estate purposes, congregational growth and ministry resources and creating new forms of ministry. See www.toronto.anglican.ca/parish-administry-allocation-fund-grants/.

Our Faith-Our Hope: Re-Imagine Church Grants provide financial resources to renew, re-imagine, and revitalize the Church of tomorrow. See www.toronto.anglican.ca/parish-administration/grants-funding/our-faith-our-hope-re-imagine-church-grants/. Applications should address the following strategic objectives — Building the Church for Tomorrow or Revitalizing Our Inheritance. Applications for OFOH Grants are received twice a year April and September. The next deadline is April 15, 2017.

Reach Grants are becoming increasingly successful at funding new ministry that is aimed at reaching un-churched and de-churched people. The purpose of a Reach grant is to provide one time funding (of up to \$5000) for ministry that is aimed at connecting with those not currently being reached by traditional parish ministry. Stretch Grants are one-time grants of \$5,000-\$20,000 designed to be a continuance grant for a successful Reach grant ministry. See www.toronto.anglican.ca/parish-life/mission-shaped-parish/stretch-grants-the-next-generation. If you have any questions or would like additional information, please contact the Rev. The Anglican Foundation of Canada distributes grants and loans to causes that are either new or for which funds are not easily accessed or financed. Programs supported by the Foundation can range from building projects, accessibility upgrades, creative arts programs, theological student bursaries, camps, aboriginal prayer and peace circles, and much more. Application deadlines are March 1 and August 1 each year. Beginning in 2014 AFC is setting aside \$50,000 annually to encourage and fund innovative ministry related projects. More detail can be found on their website www.anglicanfoundation.org. Keep in mind that all applications to AFC must be approved by the Diocesan Council so everything should be submitted one month before the March or August Council meetings (as they don't always schedule an August meeting you need to contact Pam Boisvert for the deadline. See www.toronto.anglican.ca/parish-administration/grants-funding/anglican-foundation-of-canada-2/.

PLEASE NOTE

For churches who have been given permission to do a Notice to Reader or a Review Engagement instead of a full Audit of your finances (as per Canon 15, section 14) remember that you may be required to provide an audited financial statement before being awarded a grant. To avoid disappointment and unnecessary work make sure you review all the requirements of the grant before you proceed.
