Position Details

The Manager, Major Gifts and Legacy Giving will coordinate all aspects of the fund development plan for the Anglican Diocese of Toronto Foundation. The Manager will be self-motivated, able to work independently, as well as part of a team and will work to cultivate individual "high-end" giving.

Major Responsibilities

- Identify and cultivate major gift and legacy giving prospects from current data base.
- Research, cultivate and solicit new major gift prospects.
- Coach and motivate a team of volunteers in support of the gift giving process.
- Provide information on the different giving vehicles to prospective legacy giving donors.
- Coordinate financial reporting activities and ensure all program records and material are kept current.
- Support parish leadership in promotion of major gift and legacy giving and establishment of their own endowments
- Arrange face-to-face visits and cultivation events as necessary.
- Update and create major gift and legacy giving marketing materials.
- Ensure donors receive appropriate recognition, updates and regular communications.
- Prepare and monitor fund raising plan for the Foundation.

Qualifications

- University degree or equivalent combination of experience and education.
- At least 5 years demonstrated performance in major gift and gift planning work.
- Consistent record of securing five-figured gifts and higher.
- The ability to present oneself in a professional and positive manner.
- Ability to interact effectively with individuals at all levels of the organization.
- Demonstrated analytical and management skills and experience with Raiser's Edge.
- Professional designation (CFRE, CGPP).
- Effective written and oral communication skills.
- Results oriented mindset.
- Able to work independently from a home office and as part of a team.
