

Insurance Requirements: Weddings and Funerals

Please see the following list of examples provided as a guide for when third-party insurance is required for a funeral or wedding event:

Wedding ceremony of a parishioner	No third-party insurance required. Event is part of church activities.
Wedding ceremony of a non-parishioner	No third-party insurance required. Event is part of church activities.
After wedding reception (tea and coffee)	No third-party insurance required. Event is part of church activities.
Wedding “reception” (dinner and dance)	Yes third-party insurance is required since a third-party is using church property for an event that is not part of church activities.
Funeral of a parishioner	No third-party insurance required. Event is part of church activities.
Funeral of a non-parishioner	No third-party insurance required. Event is part of church activities.
After funeral reception (tea and coffee)	No third-party insurance required. Event is part of church activities.
