#### Family Activities:

#### Activity 1: Create a Family Prayer

On page 2 you will find a family prayer fill in the blank. Create a prayer together that your family can say all week (maybe before a meal, before bed, or even right when you get up in the morning). You can fill in the blanks verbally or by writing things down anytime your family prays. Your family can use the same prayer all week, make a new prayer every day with this template, or create a template of your own!

#### Activity 2: Individual Blessing Jars

On page 3 are instructions for how each person in your family can make a blessing jar. Every day on a small piece of paper each family member should write down or draw something that they were grateful for - something that was a blessing! Each person puts their piece of paper into their own blessing jar and you can go through all of your blessings at the end of the week either as a family or individually.







# Creating Blessing Jars:

### Materials:

- one glass/plastic jar, cup, or box per person (this is your blessing jar)
- any scrap papers (either blank or coloured) for decorating
- any stickers for decorating
- Crayons, markers, pencil crayons etc. for decorating

### **Directions:**


- 1. Give each person their blessing jar
- 2. Everyone decorates their own blessing jar anyway they like with the materials you have available
- 3. Each day this week on a piece of paper everyone will write or draw something they are thankful for (a blessing!) and put their piece of paper in their blessing jar
- 4. Watch the jars fill up with blessings, and at the end of the week your family can read through blessings of the week

The only rule: No one is allowed to peak into each other's blessing jar without permission from the jar owner
