Working with York-Scarborough Area Council, and with the Area's other Youth Ministry Coordinator, the Coordinator will engage and equip youth ministry leaders to continue to cultivate youth faith formation in their parishes and communities, paying particular attention to the new challenges emerging as a result of the COVID-19 pandemic.

The Coordinator will maintain communication with parishes and parish leadership to support and animate youth ministry, and will seek innovative ways to enhance connections throughout the Area. The Area Coordinator will also be an active member of the Bishop's Youth Ministry Committee, which plans youth events and promotes youth ministry in the Diocese.

This is a part time (7 hours per week) paid, one-year renewable contract position.
