For food and drink and friendship, we offer thanks. Bless, O Lord, our table; deepen our gratitude; enlarge our sympathies; and order our affections in generous and unselfish lives; for Jesus Christ's sake. **AMEN**.

We give you thanks, Creator God, that you have made your home among us. When we wander away and realize we are lost, you love us still and bring us home. We thank you for sending Jesus your Son to show us how much you love us; he lived and died and rose for us, and is coming in glory to reign.
