Ministry Position Title: Youth Minister

St. Clements is currently seeking a creative and enthusiastic part-time Youth Minister to foster a passion for Christ among youth by providing creative, relevant and age-appropriate programming, teaching and pastoral care dedicated to faith formation in the context of a Family Ministries team.

Duties and Responsibilities:

- Forming young people (Junior & Senior Youth) as followers of Jesus via:
 - Sunday morning worship/education
 - Mid-week evening youth group activities
 - Confirmation preparation
 - Ongoing pastoral care
 - Healthy and supportive partnerships with parents
- Recruit, train and manage Youth Ministry volunteer leaders
- Participate fully as an active member of the staff team
- Work with the Family Ministry team to create a cohesive vision for ministry with families
- Plan and lead key youth events such as the Maundy Thursday Vigil
- Encourage participation of youth within the parish community through common worship, volunteer ministry roles, and special events (e.g. Mardi Gras)
- Organize separate social and service events throughout the year
- Other duties as assigned

Skills, Knowledge and Experience Required:

- A baptized follower of Jesus who worships regularly with a church community
- Passionate about the spiritual formation and discipleship of adolescents
- Experience working with pre-teens and teenagers
- Confident teaching the faith to teenagers
- Ability to engage in diverse theological conversations and a willingness to openly explore questions with youth
- A person with initiative who is able to plan and implement innovative programming
- Passionate about leadership development with experience developing leaders (teenagers and volunteers)
- Adept with social media
- Strong communications skills
- Excited about collaborating with a strong team

Terms:

- One year contract commencing in March 2024
- Salary range: \$22 -\$24/hr commensurate with education and experience
- 20 hours per week, with a focus on Sunday mornings, Tuesday evenings and Tuesday staff meetings. However, due to the nature of the work, some weeks will involve more hours, which will be balanced with fewer hours other weeks. The most concentrated periods of work are Advent/Christmas, Lent/Holy Week, and September. There are also evening commitments to Midweek Youth Group/Confirmation Class (typically Tuesday evenings).
- This position reports to and works closely with our Associate Priest overseeing Family Ministries.
