St Barnabas Children & Community Ministry Position Description

The Leadership of the Parish is looking to provide activities for an Outreach effort to the neighbourhood for those who are of public school age. We are also looking for someone who would organize and teach the Sunday School, known as the "Spirit Squad".

The Children & Community Minister would be part of the Ministry Team, and would report to the Incumbent and/or the Leadership Team.

This position requires a person with a love of Christ and Children, who will ensure that a safe space is provided for the ministry. They will be responsible for appropriate records to be kept in a confidential manner, that volunteers involved conform to the screening requirements of the Diocese and that the budget is adhered to.

Specific Requirements:

- Will be responsible for teaching and guiding the children in their faith on Sundays during worship time
- Will, in discussion with the Incumbent, implement a program for the Sunday School to follow
- Will organise and hold an outreach event to children in the area at least monthly
- Will ensure that any programs organised fit in with others use of our space and do not conflict with the programs offered by the Day Care
- Will utilize various types of social media to ensure continuous and active involvement with the children, their families and any possible youth
- Will plan, in consultation with the Incumbent participation in a church service in some way on a regular basis
- Will interact with members of the Sunday School parents and members of the congregation, specifically at coffee hour after services

Qualifications

- Several years of Children's ministry experience would be good
- Some level of theological training preferred
- Be organized, a self-starter who can work with minimal supervision
- Desire to share their faith with others
- Be able to organise, schedule and run gatherings, events & activities

The position will run from Sept 2nd, 2024 until June 15th, 2024 with the expectation of 10 hrs per week required.

Remuneration will be based on a rate of \$27 per hour.
