

DOUGLAS C COWLING BURSARY IN LITURGICAL MUSIC

2024 Call for submissions

Clergy and Church musicians in the Anglican Diocese of Toronto

Are you looking for ways of developing, supporting, and encouraging creative musical and liturgical experimentation? The Douglas C. Cowling Bursary aims to foster liturgical participation by all age-groups of the 'people of God'. This bursary aims to support clergy and musicians to collaborate, foster and implement programming to enhance worship and musical creativity in your congregation with special attention to the opportunities and challenges of this time in the life of the Anglican Church.

Cowling Liturgical Music Grant

Bursary (\$5,000-10,000) awarded to a parish in the Diocese of Toronto to support the music staff to further **liturgical training** or provide creative **liturgical programming** in the musician's ecclesial setting. Projects must support creativity and innovation in music and liturgy in the post-pandemic era.

- **Liturgical programming** can include but is not limited to: special events & gathering, community programming around music, congregation and community outreach, a conference or gathering, a multi-parish project using digital tools to support worship.
- **Liturgical training** for music staff can include but is not limited to: workshops, retreats, guest lecturers, musical coaches etc.

Applicants should outline how they intend to use the funds consistent with the Bursary's purpose to foster liturgical participation by all age-groups of the 'people of God'.

***Please note, this grant does not support the capital purchase of technology, but instead supports programming. Technological support can be included in the grant if it is necessary to the implementation of your programming.

Proposal package to include

- Detailed proposal.
- Resume of program leader and others involved in the project
- Detailed budget outlining how you intend to use the funds
- Letters of support from potential partners including the parish corporation.

Proposal deadline – November 30, 2024
