- Topics Covered: Suffering, Grieving, Lamenting, Forgiveness, Rebuilding, Resilience

Addictions: Overcomers Program

- Overview: A Bible-based 12-step recovery program recognized by the Parole Board of Canada.
- **Benefits**: Supports individuals with addictions and life-controlling issues, improving parole outcomes for incarcerated participants

Elderly Support

- **Devices**: Dementia-friendly audio Bible devices available in 50+ languages.
- Features: Color-coded buttons, solar-powered, resistant to liquids and drops, equipped with 100 instrumental hymns. The audio Bible comes equipped in NIV or KJV.

Diaspora Initiatives

- **Seminars**: Intergenerational and preaching seminars.
- Resources: Scripture resources in foreign languages to engage newcomers and diverse communities.
