Tips for Reimagining Evangelism

1. Start with Presence, Not Programs

Cultivate authentic relationships before inviting people into events or courses. Evangelism flows best through trust, not tactics.

2. Create a Culture, Not a Moment

Move from one-time initiatives to a community-wide mindset where sharing faith is normalized and celebrated.

3. Prioritize Personal Invitation

Reople are more open than we assume—extend simple, relational invitations to conversation, coffee, or community.

4. Practice Hospitality as Mission

Use dinner tables, porches, and homes as sacred spaces where connection leads to spiritual curiosity.

5. Tell the Gospel as a Story, Not a Script

Share faith through narrative, testimony, and lived experience rather than formulas or pressure.

6. Engage the Digital Frontier Intentionally

Online spaces are modern mission fields—leverage technology to connect, listen, and engage meaningfully.

7. Collaborate Beyond Your Church Walls

Partnerships with other churches, ministries, and community organizations multiply reach and impact.

8. Pay Attention to the Next Generation

Equip young people with imagination, ownership, and opportunities to reach their peers and lead now.

9. Welcome Newcomers and the Nations Among Us

Engage international students, immigrants, and refugees through hospitality, language, and shared belonging.

10. Pray First, Act Second

Evangelism is Spirit-led work. Root strategies in prayer, listening, and dependence on God's leading.
