Church Aurora

Organ Scholar Program

Background

The Anglican parish of Trinity Church, Aurora seeks the services of an organ scholar to support our music program. Established in 1846, Trinity Aurora is located in the historical section of town, approximately 35 km north of Toronto. Trinity is a vibrant worshipping community which supports strong musical leadership in its liturgy. The intent of this scholarship is to provide the candidate with performance experience in a liturgical setting, as part of their educational development.

Key Competencies

- Undergrad or graduate university student currently enrolled in an organ performance program;
- Musical and technical proficiency, including a strong aptitude to improvise during transition periods in a liturgical setting;
- An eagerness for creating inspirational church music;
- Consistency; the candidate must be reliable.
- Able to work collaboratively and under the direction of the Director of Music

Duties

- Support the music program under the guidance of Trinity Director of Music;
- Provide weekly instrumental support (piano/organ) during Thursday evening choir practices; occasional extra practices prior to festival and seasonal services.
- Play the organ weekly, during the 9:15 am Sunday service - time off will be granted every 6 weeks;
- Play the organ for high festival/ observance services: e.g. Advent Festival of Lessons and Carols, Christmas, Ash Wednesday, Maundy Thursday, Good Friday, Great Vigil of Easter, Deanery Evensong services;
- May be called upon to direct the choir, on occasion, as designated by Trinity Music Director;
- May be called upon to perform at an organ recital.

Term

- Program will be for a 10 month period, from September 2026 through June 2027;
- Scholarship remuneration \$10,000 for the term; payable \$1,000 monthly over the term.
